- To submit an answer, text it in using the format: “[puzzle number] [answer]”. For example, if your answer for puzzle #6 was “fish”, you would text **6 fish**.
- Spongebob’s Friends at the **front desk** are available for help. General tips:
  - Look for patterns between the parts of the puzzle, and try to stay organized.
  - The title and the flavortext may have some subtle clues.
  - If you need a hint, feel free to ask any of Spongebob's Friends!
